IMUA AND IBANY TEAM UP AGAIN TO PRESENT ADVANCED TRUCKING SEMINAR

Commercial Auto Physical Damage

- Claims adjusting considerations

MTC Trailer Interchange

- What an interchange agreement is and why it's required.
- First party exposure & loss payee - Do you understand the risk?
- Difference between bailee coverage and trailer interchange coverage.

Towing & Storage Expenses

- Extra contractual exposures when claim delays result in increased storage charges.
- Possible inadequate limit left for cargo loss if paid as an MTC limit.
